TORONTO, March 26, 2018 – *Biblio Bash*, Toronto's must-attend gala for library lovers and city builders returns on Thursday, April 26, 2018. The Toronto Public Library Foundation's (TPLF) annual fundraiser, presented by TD, will raise vital funds for Toronto Public Library (TPL), transform the Toronto Reference Library into a glamorous black-tie soirée showcasing the 21st century library, and bring together Canada's top authors, local philanthropists, entrepreneurs, arts and culture supporters, donors, business executives and fans of Toronto Public Library.

This intimate evening, led by ***Biblio Bash*** Committee Chair Victoria Webster, will celebrate the world's busiest public library system and shine a spotlight on TPL programs and services that empower vulnerable youth in Toronto neighbourhoods. The Toronto Public Library is so much more than books, and in 2017, ***Biblio Bash*** raised over \$600,000 to support digital innovation at the highest needs branches. This year's ambitious fundraising goal is to surpass 2017, with money raised on the gala night to provide Toronto youth with such essentials as: free access to quality after-school homework help, technology, digital and financial literacy learning, and opportunities to participate in enriching programs that help develop social, creative, life and leadership skills.

"Last year, TPL Youth Hub visits doubled from the year before, so it's very apparent to our Library staff that there's an ongoing need for these dedicated youth-focused initiatives," commented City Librarian, Vickery Bowles. "Toronto Public Library genuinely contributes to positive outcomes for youth with a strong emphasis on personal development, equitable access and learning. The Library is both a space where young people are welcome and supported, and it's because of the tremendous support of ***Biblio Bash*** donors, sponsors and volunteers that we will be able to invest even further in these areas of TPL."

Each table will feature a Canadian author host with the list of 43 authors including *Giller Prize* winners **Michael Redhill** (*Bellevue Square, 2017*) and **Esi Edugyan** (*Half-Blood Blues, 2011*); New York Times Bestseller **Shari Lapena** (*The Couple Next Door*); Toronto chef and cookbook author **Matt Dean Pettit**; novelist, screenwriter and journalist **Heather O'Neill** (*Lullabies for Little Criminals*); Order of Canada recipients, author **Joy Kogawa** (*Obasan*), author **Thomas King** (*The Inconvenient Indian*) and children's poet **Dennis Lee** (*Alligator Pie*); and acclaimed author and playwright **Ann-Marie MacDonald**.

Used by over 70 per cent of Torontonians, Toronto Public Library offers a diverse selection of services and programs including welcoming, safe public spaces equipped with books, free Wi-Fi and public computers in neighbourhoods across the city; programs ranging from kids' story time to literary and cultural events; and access to eBooks, streaming video and music.
